ROYALS WILL BE OPEN MINDED AND RESPECTFUL

In these uncertain times, we must be open-minded and respectful of other families situations and choices.

Some families have chosen to send their kids to school in June and others have not.

Both choices are good.

Both choices offer continued learning opportunities, though different than in April and May.

ROYALS WILL BE SAFE

All education partners have been working very hard to make sure we are ready for students to return this month.

Measures have been put in place to help keep everyone safe and healthy.



1. STAY HOME WHEN SICK

All children and staff with common cold, influenza, COVID-19, or other respiratory diseases must stay home and self-isolate.



2. HAND HYGIENE

Everyone should wash their hands more often!

Thorough hand washing with plain soap and water for at least 20 seconds is the most effective way to reduce the spread of illness.



3. RESPIRATORY AND PERSONAL HYGIENE

Cover your coughs.

Do not touch your face.

No sharing of food, drinks, or personal items.



4. PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND MINIMIZING PHYSICAL CONTACT

Spread children out to different areas.

Take them outside more often.

Stagger lunch times. Incorporate individual activities.

Remind children, "Hands to Yourself!"



5. CLEANING AND DISINFECTION

Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at least twice a day.

General cleaning of the centre should occur at least once a day.

Use common cleaning and disinfectant products.

SOME ROYALS WILL RETURN...

RO - SAME AWESOME SCHOOL... WITH A NEW FEEL

When you come back to school it will not be **exactly** the same.

- You will have to line up outside and wait to come in. Find the cone with your teachers name or picture on it.
- You will be seeing some of your old classmates and friends but not all
- There will be no more than 10 students in a class at a time and 50 out at recess



STAGGERED SCHEDULES

- Most ROYALS will come to school 2 days a week: Tuesday/Wednesday OR Thursday/Friday
- Some of the older students will be at school 1 day a week
- Half the families will be on one schedule and half on another within each of these 2 day groups.
- These staggered schedules will allow for smaller numbers of students on the playground, in the line-ups, at the entrances, in the hallways etc
- Parents will drop you off at the playground and meet you back there at the end of the day. **Parents will not be in the school** (unless by appointment at the office)

ROYALS WILL WASH THEIR HANDS

It is important that you wash your hands for a full 20 seconds with soap and water.

Singing the ABC song is a good way to measure 20 seconds!

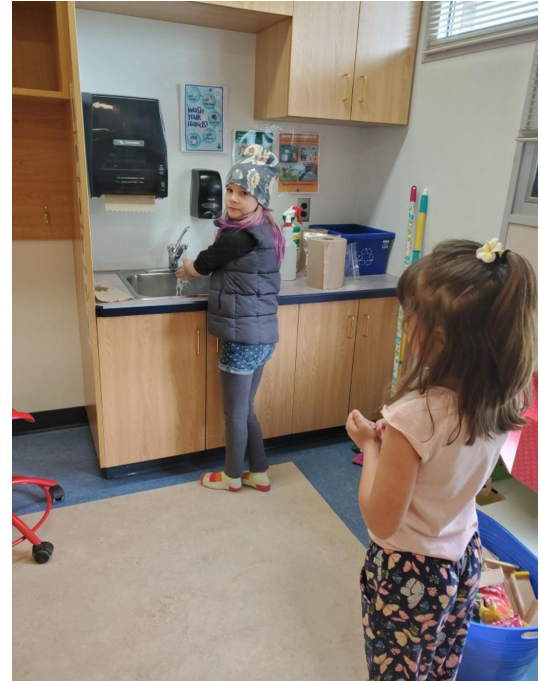
Use a paper towel to dry and throw it in the garbage when you are done.



ROYALS WILL BE PATIENT!

You will have to line up and **wait, without touching anyone**, for your turn to wash hands. You will have to do this every time:

1. You come inside from outside.
2. You go outside to play.
3. Before you eat & after you eat.
4. After you go to bathroom.
5. After you touch your face.
6. After you sneeze, cough, or blow your nose.



ROYALS WILL STAY HYDRATED!

Students are asked to bring a water bottle everyday.

- To limit contact, water fountains will be shut off.
- The bottle filling stations will be working.



ROYALS WILL PRACTICE GOOD HYGIENE

Cough and sneeze “*Dab Style*”. Wash your hands after!

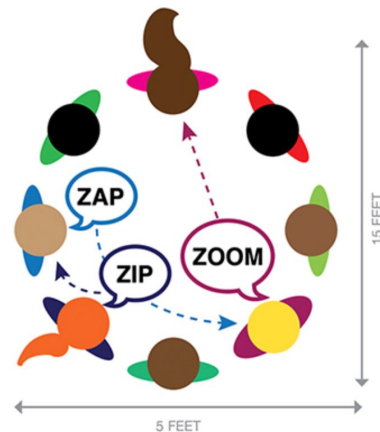


ROYALS WILL RESPECT OTHERS' SPACE !

with my whole heart and mind

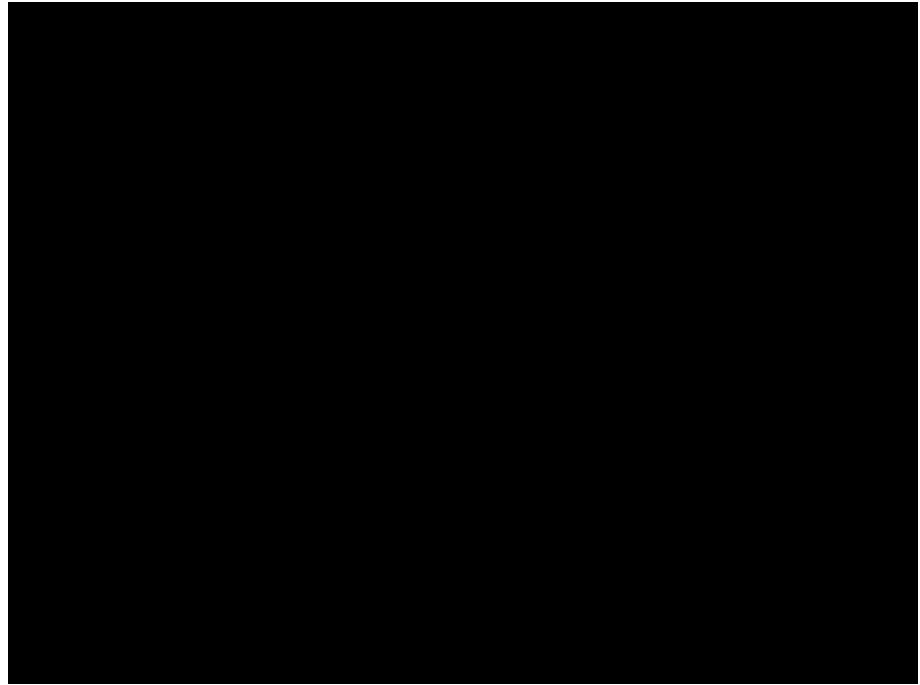
